Alaska Republican Party Resolution Opposing US Senate Trial

1. Whereas, the United States Constitution Article II, Section 4 provides: “President, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States shall be **removed from office** on impeachment for and conviction of Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors;” and
2. Whereas, the Impeachment Clause was meant to create a check against abuses by sitting government officials; and,
3. Whereas, former President Trump is now a private citizen, no longer holding any public office; and
4. Whereas, the U.S. Senate no longer has any trial jurisdiction over former President Trump, as a private citizen no longer holding public office; therefore, be it resolved:

The Alaska Republican Party opposes the U.S. Senate trial of former President Trump, as moot; and finally,

The Alaska Republican Party opposes conviction of former President Trump in the US Senate.
