Juneau

Welcome to Alaska's Capital City! Juneau was founded with the discovery of gold in 1880, and mining continues to play a key role in its economy along with tourism, fishing, and government.



Whether you enjoy the political scene or the natural scenery, Juneau has something for everyone. Tour the State Capitol, take a

hike on a trail in view of the Mendenhall Glacier or stroll through historic downtown for some great shopping.

Sitka

Located on Baranof Island, Sitka is the original Russian capital of Alaska, known as New Archangel. Its Russian influence can still be seen in the onion dome at St. Michael's Cathedral and at Castle Hill downtown. Fishing is a large part of its economy, ranking in the top 20 U.S. ports for pounds and value of seafood landed. Sitka's stunning coastal location in view of the dormant volcano Mt. Edgecumbe provides unique opportunities for outdoor recreation and enjoyment of the natural beauty of Baranof Island and the Pacific Ocean.

Ketchikan

Alaska's "First City" is so named because it's the first major landfall for most cruisers as they enter the picturesque fjords of the Inside Passage, although on our cruise, it is the last port of call. Ketchikan is resource rich and Republican leaning. It has long been an important hub of the salmon-fishing and-packing industries and until recently had a strong timber industry. Ketchikan has remained a resilient community through building its tourism-related businesses.

Hoonah



Tourism has revitalized this small fishing village with the opening

of **Icy Strait Point** in 2004. The Huna Tlingit are the original inhabitants of nearby Glacier Bay and were pushed to their current location of Hoonah by advancing glaciers during the last Little Ice Age. With abundant fish in the region, the Hoonah Packing Company built a cannery on the site over 100 years ago. Today **Icy Strait Point** is a testament to economic development that honors the past while creating jobs for the present and future of this charming town.
